

Description	Explanation.
APNO	Any advanced payments made on shipments more than R50 0000 with relevant APN number
Currency	Must be indicated in iso 4217 currency code 3 alphabetical characters example USD
Intercoms	Terms of sale must be indicated -Example FCA -*Written into contract of sale, matching the buyers/sellers cost, risk and responsibility of the transaction
Hs code	Tariff code of each line as per suppliers record.
Invoice number	Unique invoice number provided by supplier
Invoice Date	Unique date of transaction as per suppliers records
Supplier details	Full name and physical address and contact details
Purchasers details	Full name and physical address and contact details
Commercial description	Description of goods -example model
Payment terms	This indicates the conditions agreed upon by a buyer and seller regarding how and when a payment for goods or services is due, including the due date, accepted payment methods,
SKU number	“stock keeping unit,” and, as the name suggests, it is a number (usually eight alphanumeric digits) that retailers assign to products to keep track of stock levels internally.
Price per unit	Price in currency per unit/kg/
Discount	Discount must be shown if applied.
Product code	Code can be alpha numeric as per suppliers records.
Statistical unit as per hs code	This is the statistical code as shown in the tariff book determined by the WCO
Country or Origin/COO	This refers to where the goods were deemed to be manufactured
